Increasing water allocations for the Peel Valley

DPI Water today announced an increase to available water determinations for Peel Valley water users.

Recent rain and snow falls in the Peel Valley catchment have resulted in significant inflows to Chaffey Dam.

In the Peel Regulated River water source, allocations for local water utility, domestic and stock, and high security water access licence holders will increase to 100 per cent of entitlement.

Additionally, general security water access licence holders will receive 12 per cent of entitlement.

In the Peel Alluvium water source, aquifer (general security) access licence holders will receive a six per cent increase, bringing allocations to 57 per cent of entitlement.

DPI Water will continue to closely monitor the situation and may make subsequent available water determinations as further water becomes available.
