

Water Allocation Statement

1 July 2016

Allocations for Deua Valley water users

DPI Water today announced available water determinations for Deua Valley water users for the new 2016/17 water year, commencing 1 July 2016.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Deua unregulated and alluvial water sources will receive an allocation of 200 per cent of entitlement or 2 megalitres per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.

Water sources covered by this plan include Araluen Creek, Bettowynd and Moodong Creeks, Burra Creek, Deua River, Mogendoura Creek, Moruya River, Upper Deua River and Wamban Creek.
