All water that requires a license to be extracted should be metered . Landholders who use in excess of 100 MgLt per year should have telemetric monitoring where it is feasible. Landholders who use less than 100 MgLt per year could have metres read once per year. All metres should be an industry wide standard design , be numbered and be sealed upon installation. Should a meter become damaged or fail to work for some reason , the water user would be required to notify the relevant authority to rectify the problem. Unauthorised tampering with meters should be met with hefty fines .
