## Allocations for South Coast groundwater users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced available water determinations for South Coast area groundwater users for the new 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

Local water utility access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast and South East Coastal Sands groundwater sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Aquifer access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer access licence holders who draw from the South East Coastal Sands groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer access licence holders who draw from the Sydney Basin – South Coast groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
