Enter text below or upload a document: As a group we have a concern with the meter policy. * The majority of water users in the tidal pool have outlets greater than 100mm but have less than a 100meg license. * There is no risk of any irrigator taking more than their licensed amount & threatening the other water users or the environmental flows. * A number of the water users have multiple sites because of the course of the river & therefore would need multiple meters. A very prohibitive cost if the meters that have telemetry are required....definitely a sledgehammer to crack a nut. * Flood waters in the tidal pool are very fast rising. To protect the pump & meter they would need to be removed to the top of the bank . Difficult when there are multiple sites. * The cost of reading water meters is high. Electricity meters are already read...it is our understanding that electricity meters are accurate to +/- 5% in assessing the amount of water extracted. If it is deemed necessary to have some form of measurement, then electricity meters would be the best for us
