Independent panel seeking feedback on management of the Northern Basin 'first flush event'

13/05/2020

In mid-January to early February 2020, the NSW Government put in place water restrictions to manage the first major water flows following rainfall across the northern Murray-Darling after record drought conditions ('the first flush event').

This was the first time NSW managed a first-flush event under these

conditions. The NSW Government has appointed an independent panel to assess what improvements can be made to better manage events like this in future.
