Allocations for South Coast groundwater users

DPI Water today announced available water determinations for South Coast area groundwater users for the new 2017/18 water year, commencing 1 July 2017.

Local water utility water access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast and South East Coastal Sands groundwater sources will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast groundwater source will receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the South East Coastal Sands groundwater source will receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Sydney Basin – South Coast groundwater source will receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
