Allocations announced for the NSW Great Artesian Basin water users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced available water determinations for the NSW Great Artesian Basin groundwater sources for the new 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

Domestic and stock, domestic and stock (conveyance), local water utility and aquifer access licence holders who draw from the Southern Recharge, Surat, Warrego and Central groundwater sources, all receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Domestic and stock, domestic and stock (conveyance), local water utility access licence holders who draw from the Eastern Recharge groundwater source, all receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Aquifer access licence holders who draw from the Eastern Recharge groundwater source receive an allocation of 0.5 megalitres per unit share of entitlement.

Water access licence holders covered by the water sharing plan for the NSW Great Artesian Basin shallow groundwater sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of their entitlement.
