## **Explanatory note**

This Order is made under section 59 (1) (a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*. The object of this Order is to make an available water determination for various categories of access licences in the water sources identified in Schedule 1.

## **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Available Water Determination Order for the Barwon-Darling Unregulated and Alluvial Water Sources 2018*.

## **2 Commencement**

This Order commences on the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2018.

## **3 Available water determination**

This Order determines the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedules 2 and 3, on the terms specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

## **Schedule 1 Water Sources**

This Order applies to all water sources to which the *Water Sharing Plan for the Barwon-Darling Unregulated and Alluvial Water Sources 2012* applies.

## Schedule 2 Category of access licence

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category/ subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.

<b>Category/subcategory of access licence</b>	<b>Percentage per megalitre of access licence share component</b>
Domestic and stock access licences	100%
Local water utility access licences	100%
Salinity and water table management access licences	100%

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the adjacent category/ subcategory of access licence specified in Column 1.

Aquifer access licences	1.0 megalitre

Notes: (1) An available water determination made in relation to a particular category of access licence applies to all subcategories of that category, except to the extent to which this order provides otherwise, in accordance with section 59 (1A) of the *Water Management Act 2000*.
