Explanatory note

This Order is made under section 59 (1) (a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*. The object of this Order is to make an available water determination for various categories of access licences in the water sources identified in Schedule 1.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Available Water Determination Order for the Peel Valley Regulated, Unregulated, Alluvium and Fractured Rock Water Sources 2018 (No. 2)*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 16th August 2018.

3 Available water determination

This Order determines the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories of access licence specified in Schedules 2 and 3, and on the terms specified in Schedules 2 and 3.

Schedule 1 Water sources

This Order applies to the regulated and alluvium water sources to which *the Water Sharing Plan for the Peel Valley Regulated, Unregulated, Alluvium and Fractured Rock Water Sources 2010* applies.

Schedule 2 Regulated river (general security) access licences

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to the regulated river (general security) access licences with a share component that specifies the adjacent water source specified in Column 1.

Schedule 3 Aquifer (general security) access licences
