### **Allocations for South Coast groundwater users**

DPI Water today announced available water determinations for South Coast area groundwater users for the new 2016/17 water year, commencing 1 July 2016, in line with the rules for the new water sharing plan for the South Coast groundwater sources.

Local water utility water access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast and South East Coastal Sands groundwater sources will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast groundwater source will receive 1.1 megalitres per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the South East Coastal Sands groundwater source will receive 1 megalitre per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Sydney Basin – South Coast groundwater source will receive 1.25 megalitres per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.
