Water allocations for Barwon-Darling water users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced available water determinations for water users in the Barwon-Darling unregulated and alluvial water sources for the 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

Local water utility, domestic and stock and salinity and water table management access licence holders will receive 100 per cent of entitlement.

Aquifer access licence holders will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.

Unregulated River and Unregulated River A Class, B Class and C Class access licence holders will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.

Water sources covered include the Barwon-Darling unregulated river water source and the Upper Darling alluvial groundwater source. These water sources also include the towns of Mungindi, Collarenebri, Walgett, Brewarrina, Bourke, Louth and Wilcannia.
