Full allocations for Central Coast water users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced the available water determinations for Central Coast water users for the new 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

All water access licence holders on the Jiliby Jiliby, Ourimbah, Mooney Mooney and Mangrove creeks, together with Brisbane Water, Tuggerah Lakes and Wyong River surface water sources, will receive an allocation 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Aquifer access licence holders covered by the Central Coast unregulated water sources water sharing plan will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

All water access licence holders who draw water from the Kulnura Mangrove Mountain groundwater source, which is part of the North Coast fractured and porous rock groundwater sources water sharing plan, will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of their entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.
