

# Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project

## Community update – December 2018 - January 2019

*Jointly funded by the Australian Government, NSW Government and Bega Valley Shire Council, the \$44 million Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project is an important multi-government initiative to drive economic growth in the region.*


### Stage Two - Marine Structures nearing completion

Waterway Construction's work on stage two marine structures is nearing completion. Work to be undertaken in December and January includes:

- on driving of wharf piles
- trimming piles
- pouring concrete for onshore bollards and main wharf structures
- installing deck planks, headstocks, dolphin topsides, pile jackets and anodes for corrosion protection
- testing and commissioning hydraulic services and electrical services
- installing fenders, bollards, life buoys and wharf ladders
- preparing an Operation and Maintenance Manual.

Driving of piles and associated work activities will continue to be undertaken during normal construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm Saturday**. Piling activities will not be continuous throughout the work day and there will be a scheduled respite period of one hour between 12pm and 2pm Monday to Friday. There will also be non-scheduled respite periods during piling work such as moving barges, positioning piling rigs, and preparing and lifting piles and equipment into place.

The project remains on schedule to be completed in early 2019.

## Operational Environmental Management Plans

The NSW Department of Industry (DoI) called open tenders for a consultant to develop documentation required to operate the Eden Cruise Ship Facility in accordance with the State Significant Infrastructure (SSI) approval and all other project permits, licences and approvals. Tenders closed in September 2018 with the contract awarded to Cardno (NSW/ACT) Pty Ltd (Cardno). Cardno has prepared an Operational Environmental Management Plan (OEMP), and OEMP sub-plans which includes:

- Traffic, Transport and Access Sub-Plan;
- Noise Management Sub-Plan; and
- Air Quality Management Sub-Plan
