## Opening water allocations for South Coast groundwater users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for South Coast area groundwater users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Local water utility water access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast and South East Coastal Sands groundwater sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Lachlan Fold Belt Coast groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the South East Coastal Sands groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Sydney Basin – South Coast groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
