Definitions

Suspicious activity reports: These are reports filed when a person notifies NRAR that they believe a breach of the *Water Management Act 2000* or the *Water Act 1912* has occurred or is occurring.

Investigations finalised: NRAR formally closes all alleged breach notifications once the regulator reaches a decision. The reasons for NRAR's decision are recorded in NRAR's case management system. Informants receive notification of the outcome within five working days of NRAR's decision.

Advisory letter: An advisory letter is a letter that provides advice about requirements of the *Water Management Act 2000* or *Water Act 1912*.

Formal warnings: A formal warning is a letter to an alleged offender advising there are reasonable grounds to believe they may have committed a minor breach of the *Water Management Act 2000* or the *Water Act 1912* and warning the alleged offender in relation to that breach and any future breaches of the legislation.

Statutory notice: NRAR has investigated a matter and issued a statutory direction under a provision within Chapter 7 of the *Water Management Act 2000*.

Penalty notice: NRAR has investigated a matter and issued a penalty notice under *Water Management Act 2000*.

Prosecution finalised: NRAR has investigated and a prosecution has been finalised under a provision within the *Water Management Act 2000*.
