## Allocations for Brunswick water users

DPI Water today announced available water determinations for Brunswick area water users for the new 2016/17 water year, commencing 1 July 2016.

Domestic and stock, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders on the Lower Brunswick River, Belongil Creek, Kings Creek, Lower Marshalls Creek, Mullumbimby Creek, Tallow Creek, Tyagarah Creek and Upper Marshalls Creek will receive an allocation of 200 per cent of entitlement or 2 megalitres per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.

Domestic and stock and unregulated river water access licence holders on the Upper Brunswick River will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share, while aquifer water access licence holders will receive 2 megalitres per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Brunswick River coastal floodplain alluvial groundwater source will receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
