

# Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project

## Community update – October - November 2018


*Jointly funded by the Australian Government, NSW Government and Bega Valley Shire Council, the \$44 million Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project is an important multi-government initiative to drive economic growth in the region.*

### Stage Two - Marine Structures ongoing


Waterway Constructions is continuing work on the marine structures. All of the wharf piles have been driven into the seabed to create the foundations for the new wharf extension. Work to be undertaken in October and November includes:

- piling and trimming piles to required lengths
- grout levelling and bracing dolphin piles
- installing reinforcing steel
- installing pile jackets and anodes for corrosion protection
- pouring concrete for onshore bollards, wharf transition and main wharf structures
- installing hydraulic services
- installing electrical services
- installing bollards
- installing wharf furniture
- arrival of the dolphin topsides.

Piling and associated work activities will continue to be undertaken during normal construction hours of **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm Saturday**. Piling will not be continuous throughout the work day and there will be a scheduled respite period of one hour between 12pm and 2pm Monday to Friday. There will also be non-scheduled respite periods during piling work such as moving barges, positioning piling rigs, and preparing and lifting piles and equipment into place. The project remains on schedule to be completed in early 2019.

## Supporting the local community

The Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension project was a major sponsor of the Giiyong Festival, the first cultural festival to be held in the South Coast region and in Yuin Country (Yuin country stretches from the Shoalhaven River down to the Victorian border and across to the Great Dividing Range). The Festival was held at Jigamy Farm on 22 September 2018 and celebrated local Aboriginal performers, artists and cultural producers. The Festival is a partnership between South East Arts, Twofold Aboriginal Corporation and Eden Local Aboriginal Land Council.

Sponsorship of the Giiyong Festival helped provide training, skills development and employment to local Aboriginal artists and festival staff leading up to and on the day of the Festival, and will lead to long-term employment and training opportunities for local Aboriginal people.

To date the project has been supportive of the Twofold Aboriginal Corporation and Eden Local Aboriginal Land Council through the provision of labour, materials, cultural awareness training, and training and employment for marine mammal observers.
