Allocations for Tuross Valley water users

DPI Water today announced available water determinations for Tuross Valley water users for the new 2016/17 water year, commencing 1 July 2016.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders on the Tuross River, Upper Tuross River, Wadbilliga River, Wagonga Inlet Tributaries, Woila Creek, Yowrie Creek, Belimbla Creek, Brou Lake, Bumberry Creek, Bumbo Creek, Coila Lake, Corunna Lake, Gulph Creek, Lake Mummuga, Little and Big Belimbla Creeks, Mellion Creek, Mid Tuross River, Reedy Creek, Swamp Creek, Tilba Tilba Lake and Tuross Estuary Tributaries, will receive an allocation of 200 per cent of entitlement or 2 megalitres per unit share, in line with the rules for the commencement of the new water sharing plan.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders on Wandella Creek will receive 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.
