Water allocations for the Murrumbidgee unregulated and alluvial water sources

DPI Water today announced the available water determinations for the Murrumbidgee unregulated and alluvial water source for the 2017/18 water year, beginning 1 July 2017.

Local water utility, domestic and stock, unregulated river, unregulated river high flow, aquifer and salinity and water table management water access licence holders, will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer high security water access licence holders will receive an allocation of 0.984 megalitres per unit share of entitlement.

Water sources covered by the Murrumbidgee unregulated and alluvial water sharing plan now include Adelong Creek, Tarcutta Creek and Upper Billabong Creek.
