## Allocations for Clarence Valley water users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced available water determinations for Clarence Valley water users for the new 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer access licence holders on the Aberfoyle, Angourie-Redcliff and Sandon, Boyd, Cataract, Esk River, Guy Fawkes, Henry, Little Nymboida, Lower Mann, Lower Nymboida, Lower Orara, Lower Timbarra, Maryland, Mid Mann, Mid Nymboida, Mid Orara, Upper Mann, Upper Orara, Upper Timbarra, Wooli, Sara-Oban and Yarrow rivers, Acacia, Alummy, Bookookoorara, Boonoo Boonoo, Bottle, Bucca Bucca, Coldstream, Coombadjha, Copmanhurst-Lower Mid Clarence, Dandahra, Deep-Tunglebung, Demon, Duck, Koreelah, Paddys Flat-Upper Clarence, Peacock, Plumbago, Stockyard, Swan, The Gorges-Upper Mid Clarence, Tooloom, Waspool creeks, Clarence Coastal, Clarence tidal pool and Wooloweyah Lake receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Domestic and stock, local water utility and unregulated river access licence holders on the Bielsdown, Blinks, Upper Nymboida rivers and Wild Cattle Creek receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer access licence holders who draw from the Clarence River coastal floodplain alluvial groundwater source receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
