

Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project

Information for recreational boaters

Jointly funded by the Australian Government, New South Wales Government and Bega Valley Shire Council, the \$44 million Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project is an important multi-government initiative to drive economic growth in the region.

About the project

Snug Cove, in the Port of Eden, is becoming a popular destination with an increasing number of cruise ship stop overs. Once completed, the Eden Breakwater Wharf Extension Project will allow cruise ships up to 325 metres to berth at the wharf. Construction commenced in August 2017 and includes:

- dredging of up to 230,000 cubic meters of material to improve access
- installation of scour protection on the seabed
- extending the existing wharf by approximately 110 metres
- installation of berthing and mooring dolphins
- installation of landside bollards
- installation of minor services (lighting, power and potable water).

Dredging will be completed soon. Scour protection will then be laid on the seabed adjacent to the wharf by a crane on a barge adjacent to the wharf. There will be an exclusion zone of 50 metres around the barge.

Construction of the marine structures is scheduled to commence in early 2018 and will be completed in early 2019, weather permitting.

Breakwater Wharf closure

The Breakwater Wharf has been closed to the public since August 2017 and a worksite established to ensure the safety of the public and contractors during the work. The Breakwater Wharf will reopen when the project is completed in 2019 and the public will be advised in advance.

Visiting private vessels and yachts can continue to tie up at the mooring jetty, which is situated on the western side of Snug Cove. There are also moorings available at Cocora Beach and East Boyd Bay. Should any emergency assistance be required, please contact Eden Marine Rescue at VHS Channel 16.
