Water allocations for Richmond and North Coast water users

The Office of Water today announced available water determinations for water users in the Richmond and North Coast water sources for the new 2015/16 water year, commencing 1 July 2015.

Both high security and general security access licence holders in the Richmond regulated water source will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Local water utility and domestic and stock water access licence holders in the Richmond regulated river will receive 100 per cent of entitlement.

All water access licence holders who access supplies from the unregulated and alluvial water sources covered by the water sharing plan for the Richmond River area unregulated, regulated and alluvial water sources, will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Water access licence holders in the water sharing plan areas of the Tweed River, Upper Brunswick River, Coffs Harbour, Coopers Creek, Bellinger River, Dorrigo Plateau surface water and Dorrigo Basalt groundwater, Toorumbie Creek, Commissioners Waters and Apsley River, as well as the Alstonville Plateau and Stuarts Point groundwater sources, will receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.
