Full allocations for Lower North Coast water users

The Office of Water today announced available water determinations for Lower North Coast water users for the new 2015/16 water year, commencing 1 July 2015.

All access licence holders on the Avon, Lower and Upper Barrington, Bowman, Lower and Upper Gloucester, Cooplacurripa, Lower and Upper Barnard, Lower and Upper Manning, Nowendoc, Rowleys, Myall, Coolongolook and Wallamba rivers will receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of their entitlement.

Water access licence holders, who draw water from Dingo and Myall Creeks, together with the Manning estuary tributaries, will also receive an allocation of 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of their entitlement.

Licence holders who access water from sources not covered by a water sharing plan are allocated full entitlement unless otherwise advised.
