

Water Allocation Statement

Water allocations for Richmond Valley water users

DPI Water today announced available water determinations for water users in the Richmond Valley water sources for the new 2016/17 water year, commencing 1 July 2016.

High security water access licence holders in the Richmond regulated water source will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement, while general security water access licence holders will also receive 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Local water utility and domestic and stock water access licence holders in the Richmond regulated river will receive 100 per cent of entitlement.

All water access licence holders who access supplies from the unregulated and alluvial water sources covered by the water sharing plan for the Richmond River area unregulated, regulated and alluvial water sources, will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Water sources covered by the Richmond regulated, unregulated and alluvial water sharing plan now includes Coopers Creek.
