Water allocations for Coffs Harbour and Nambucca area water users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced available water determinations for Coffs Harbour and Nambucca area water users for the new 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

Domestic and stock and local water utility access licence holders covered by the Coffs Harbour area unregulated and alluvial water sharing plan receive 100 per cent of entitlement.

Unregulated river and aquifer access licence holders also receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.

Domestic and stock and local water utility access licence holders covered by the Nambucca unregulated and alluvial water sharing plan receive 100 per cent of entitlement.

While unregulated river and aquifer access licence holders receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share.
