Allocations for Macleay Valley water users

The NSW Department of Industry today announced available water determinations for Macleay Valley water users for the new 2018-19 water year, commencing 1 July 2018.

Domestic and stock, local water utility, unregulated river and aquifer access licence holders on the Apsley, Chandler, Dyke, Gara, Georges, Styx, Tia, Yarrowitch, Oakey rivers, Bakers, Blue Mountain, Christmas, Collombatti, Dungay, Euroka, Five Day, Gills Bridge, Green Gully, Hickeys, Mungay, Nulla Nulla, Stockyard, Toorumbree creeks, Warbro Brook, Kunderang Brook, Apsley, Chandler, Coastal Mcleay, Macleay gorges, Macleay Valley, Malpas Dam, Salisbury Waters and Commissioners Waters water sources receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer access licence holders who draw from the Coastal Macleay floodplain alluvial groundwater source also receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
