Opening water allocations for Brunswick users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for Brunswick area water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Domestic and stock, unregulated river and aquifer water access licence holders on the Lower Brunswick River, Upper Brunswick River, Belongil Creek, Kings Creek, Lower Marshalls Creek, Mullumbimby Creek, Tallow Creek, Tyagarah Creek and Upper Marshalls Creek receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Aquifer water access licence holders who draw from the Brunswick River coastal floodplain alluvial groundwater source will receive 1 megalitre per unit share.
