## Opening water allocations for Central Coast water users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced the available water determinations for Central Coast water users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

All water access licence holders on the Jilliby Jilliby, Ourimbah, Mooney Mooney and Mangrove creeks, together with Brisbane Water, Tuggerah Lakes and Wyong River surface water sources, will receive an allocation 100 per cent or 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Aquifer water access licence holders covered by the Central Coast unregulated water sources water sharing plan will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

All water access licence holders who draw water from Zones 1-8 of the Kulnura-Mangrove Mountain groundwater sources will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of their entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.
