Opening water allocations for North Coast groundwater users

The NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment today announced available water determinations for North Coast fractured and porous rock groundwater users for the new 2019-20 water year, commencing 1 July 2019.

Local water utility and aquifer water access licence holders covered by the North Coast fractured and porous rock water sharing plan receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement or 1 megalitre per unit share.

Water sources covered by this plan include Alstonville Basalt Plateau, Bulahdelah Sandstone, Clarence Moreton Basin, Comboyne Basalt, Dorrigo Basalt, Gloucester Basin, Kulnura Mangrove Mountain, Liverpool Range Basalt Coast, Lorne Basin, New England Fold Belt Coast, North Coast Volcanics, Oxley Basin Coast and Sydney Basin-North Coast.
