Explanatory note

This Order is made under section 59 (1) (a) of the *Water Management Act 2000*. The object of this Order is to make an available water determination for various categories of access licences in the water sources identified in Schedule 1.

1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Available Water Determination Order for the Upper Namoi Zone 2, Cox's Creek (Mullaley to Boggabri) Groundwater Source 2017*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is signed.

3 Available water determination

This Order determines the availability of water in relation to the water sources specified in Schedule 1, for the categories and subcategories of access licence specified in Schedule 2.

Schedule 1 Water sources

This Order applies to the following water sources:

1. All water sources to which the *Water Sharing Plan for the Upper and Lower Namoi Groundwater Sources 2003* applies.

Schedule 2 Aquifer access licences

Each amount specified in Column 2 applies to aquifer access licences with a share component that specifies the adjacent water source specified in Column 1.

COLUMN 1 Water source/s	COLUMN 2 Volume per unit of access licence share component
Upper Namoi Zone 2, Cox's Creek (Mullaley to Boggabri) Groundwater Source 2017	0.10 megalitre
